

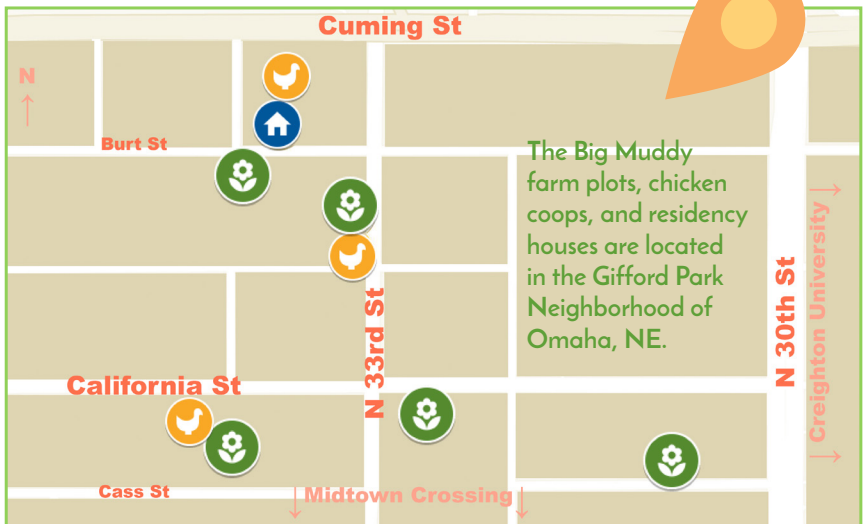

For one year, individuals work as a team to manage the Big Muddy Urban Farm's market farm operation in exchange for housing. Aside from growing food, each individual learns how to manage crops, build a business and host community events.

Big Muddy partners with the Gifford Park Community Garden at 34th and Cass Streets to provide Youth Garden programming. Youth gardeners learn the importance of growing food and preparing nutritious dishes, instilling life skills they will use for years to come.
